

Cast Care Patient Advice Leaflet

This advice leaflet is for patients who have had a cast applied to an arm or leg in the South Infirmary University Victoria Hospital, Cork

Dos and don'ts:

<u>Dos</u>

- Do keep your arm/leg ELEVATED as much as possible
- Exercise you fingers/toes frequently
- Report if your cast becomes loose, falls off, breaks, cracks, gets wet or becomes uncomfortable

(Shower covers available from local Pharmacies)

- Report an increase in pain which is not relieved with pain medicine
- If you notice excessive swelling, pins & needles, numbness, a change of colour or coldness of your fingers/toes - ELEVATE your arm/leg for 30 minutes and if no improvement is noticed within 30mins REPORT IMMEDIATELY

<u>Don'ts</u>

- Do not scratch skin under the cast with an object
- Do not put powder or lotion under the cast
- Do not wet, cut or heat cast
- If you have a cast on your leg do not put weight on leg unless advised to do so by your doctor
