



Guidelines for patients following Liquid Nitrogen Treatment (LN₂)

You have been treated today with Liquid Nitrogen

Following treatment, the area treated may:

- **Be painful – this should settle quickly**
- **Become red**
- **Develop a blister within 24hours**

Longterm side effects from LN₂ are very uncommon

The area may become paler or darkened but this should return to normal after some months. Permanent scarring from LN₂ is very uncommon.

If the area becomes:

- **Increasingly red & swollen are 48 hours**
- **Increasingly painful & tender after 48 hours**
- **Discharges after 24 hours**

Please contact you're GP , The area may have become infected & you may need antibiotic treatment.
