Symptoms of Allergic Rhinitis

You may experience one or more of the following symptoms:

- Sneezing
- Blocked or runny nose
- Itchy nose, eyes, or throat
- Frequent sore throats
- Watery eyes
- Postnasal drip
- Tiredness or poor sleep

Common Allergy Triggers

Allergic rhinitis is often caused by exposure to airborne allergens such as:

- House dust mites (All year round)
- Grass pollen (N.B Treatment needs to start before few weeks before pollen season)
- Animal dander (skin flakes, saliva, or urine)
- Tree pollen
- Mould spores

Most common being house dust mite and grass pollen

Treatment

Effective treatments include:

- 1. Intranasal Steroid Sprays
- 2. Combined Intranasal Sprays (Steroids & Antihistamine)
- 3. Antihistamines (tablets, syrups, or nasal sprays)
- 4. Allergen immunotherapy (for long-term relief)
- 5. Saline sprays and rinses

Allergen avoidance advice

Indoors (avoid pollens):

- Allergen-proof covers for pillows, duvets
- Hot wash 60°C once a week of all bedding
- <u>Vacuum</u> weekly with <u>HEPA</u> filter, use double thickness bags
- Choose hard wood, vinyl floor or tiles instead of carpet
- Fit roller blinds that can be easily wiped clean
- Reduce cuddly toys and wash at 60°C
- Avoid keeping <u>a furry/feathery pet indoor</u>/in <u>bedroom</u> and <u>bath</u> them regularly (**No** benefit from washing cats)
- Keep <u>humidity <50%</u> in house

Outdoor (avoid dust):

- Avoid being outdoors in high pollen count
- Keep car/house windows closed
- Use High-efficiency Particle Air (HEPA) air filters
- Shower, wash your hair after being outdoors
- Vacuum regularly inside of your car / Regularly vacuum baby car sit

Nasal Spray Instructions

- 1. Shake the spray before any use
- 2. Lean your head forward (chin down position)
- 3. Use your RIGHT HAND to spray your RIGHT nostril
- 4. Use your LEFT HAND to spray your LEFT nostril
- 5. Aim towards your same ear
- 6. DO NOT SNIFF IN! Breathe normally
- 7. Allow HALF AN HOUR between the saline water spray/rinse
- 8. Nasal sprays need to be used DAILY and CONTINUOUSLY, FOR A LONG TIME
- 9. Remember to clean the nozzle after use
